She provides comprehensive assessments for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), cognitive ability (IQ), specific learning disorders including dyslexia, school readiness, giftedness, and a range of developmental and educational concerns. She also has experience in vocational guidance, educational planning and identifying the supports children require to achieve success both academically and socially.

Alongside her assessment work, Cleo provides psychological therapy for children and adolescents experiencing emotional, behavioural and social difficulties. She adopts an integrative, evidence-based approach, tailoring intervention to meet the unique needs of each child and family. She also works closely with parents to develop practical strategies that strengthen relationships, build resilience and support positive behaviour at home.

Having worked as a School Guidance Counsellor for many years, Cleo has significant experience supporting both primary and secondary school students with a wide range of challenges, including anxiety, emotional regulation, grief and loss, trauma, behavioural concerns, family change, peer relationships and school engagement. She has also provided consultation and support to teachers and school leadership teams and has served in an Acting Principal role.

Following the birth of her own children, Cleo developed a particular interest in early childhood development, attachment and communication. She has undertaken additional training in Play Therapy and further developed her expertise in the assessment and support of autistic children, adopting a neuro-affirming, strengths-based approach that celebrates each child's unique profile.

Cleo believes that the best outcomes occur when families, schools and health professionals work together. She collaborates closely with parents, educators, paediatricians and allied health professionals to ensure children receive coordinated, individualised support across all areas of their lives.

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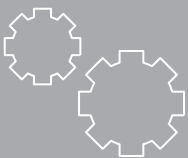
